They were the proprietors of the Anton Airline Store, Café, and the Anton Post Office since the early 1900's. Ovid's dad, Joseph Riley Shirley, bought the store in 1930 and Ovid later bought it from his father and continued running the store until 1980. The Shirley family were postmasters of the Anton Post Office from 1934-1989.
